



## 2012 NRHA DERBY CONDITIONS

1. To be held **June 24 - 30, 2012** in Oklahoma City, OK – State Fair Arena.
2. For four-, five-, and six-year-old horses – Open to all breeds – Entry must be named and licensed at the time of entry. See the current *NRHA Handbook* for information on how the age of a horse is determined. **All four- (4) year-old horses must be paid in full in the NRHA Nomination Program. See Nomination conditions for complete details.** While five- (5) and six- (6) year-old horses are not required to be nominated they are also not eligible for the nominator incentive.
3. **Payment of fees:** It is the owner's responsibility to make the payments on or before the due date even if the owner/agent has not received a payment book by the deadline. NRHA will not be responsible for entries or payments received late or lost in the mail. All fees are to be made payable to the National Reining Horse Association in U.S. funds and payments should be sent by guaranteed mail to insure delivery. When payment deadlines fall on Sunday or an official U.S. Postal Service holiday and the Postal Service is not in operation, postmarks of the next day of operation will be accepted with no late fees. An entry check returned due to insufficient funds will constitute an incomplete entry. Failure to pay applies to the rider, owner, or agent for any unpaid debts related to the entry, exhibition, showing, stalling, or any related fee of an entry at an approved NRHA event. Agent is defined as anyone who acts and/or signs on the behalf of an owner or rider (see General Rules and Regulations, G. Failure to Pay in the current *NRHA Handbook*).
4. **Post-dated checks:** If you wish to send post-dated checks for each payment with the designated coupons from the payment book, the checks will be deposited as the payment is due. If at any time you elect to drop your entry, you are required to notify the NRHA office and your remaining checks will be returned. Do not, at any time, stop payment on entry fees or late fees with your financial institution.
5. **Payment by Credit or Debit card:** If you wish to make a single payment with a credit/debit card, please call the NRHA office to obtain a "Derby Credit Card One Time Payment Authorization" form. Your card will only be charged for the payment specified on the form. It will be the responsibility of the entrant to make all subsequent payments.

If you wish for each payment to be automatically charged to your credit/debit card by the NRHA, please call the NRHA office to obtain a "Derby Credit Card Installment Payment Authorization" form. NRHA offers this service as a convenience to Derby entrants. The election must be made 10 days prior to the due date of the first payment for which you wish to start the payment program, and the election will be applicable for all remaining payments and will only be cancelled upon

written authorization by the entrant to the NRHA office. By completing, signing and returning this form to NRHA, you authorize NRHA to process your Derby payments to the debit or credit card listed. Each payment will automatically charge to your debit or credit card on the prescribed due date or the next business day.

The completed form should be mailed to the NRHA office or faxed to 405-946-8425, attention: Derby Entries. If sending by fax, please call 405-946-7400 to verify that the NRHA office has received this form. NRHA is authorized to charge the credit card for the appropriate monthly payment amounts as stated in these Conditions. There will be a 3.5% service fee per payment per entry. ***NOTE: A declined or cancelled debit or credit card will be treated as an insufficient check, all declined debit or credit card payments are subject to all applicable late fees.***

6. **Late Payments:** For horses already entered, a late fee of \$100 will be assessed to those final payments received between May 2 through June 1. Final payments received June 2 to June 14 will be assessed a \$200 late fee. Final payments received June 15 to 5pm two days prior to the go round will be assessed a \$500 late fee and will be placed within a group to run prior to the regularly drawn horses in the reverse order they are received. No final payments will be accepted after that. **POSTMARKS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED FOR THE FINAL PAYMENT.**

7. **Transfers between Derbies:** An entry may transfer from the Open to Non Pro Derby by paying a \$25 penalty. All entry payments will be applied to Non Pro entry fees and no refunds will be granted. If the entry is transferred June 15 but by 5:00 p.m. two days prior to the go round, the entry will be within a group to run prior to the regularly drawn horses in the reverse order they are received.

An entry may transfer from the Non Pro to the Open Derby by paying a \$25 penalty. All entry payments will be applied to Open entry fees and any additional fees owed must be paid to compete. If the entry is transferred June 15 but by 5:00 p.m. two days prior to the go round, the entry will be within a group to run prior to the regularly drawn horses in the reverse order they are received.

The deadline to transfer between Open and Non Pro Derbies is 5:00 p.m. two days prior to the first go round.

8. **Scratches:** The NRHA office must be notified if an entry will be scratched. At that time, any post-dated checks will be returned but no fees deposited by NRHA up to that point in time will be refunded. If the scratched entry has a balance due, that amount must be paid.
9. **Refunds:** There will be no refunds for horses entered but dropped or scratched for any reason. If any entry payment is paid in advance, the payment is non-refundable after NRHA processes the payment.
10. **Show retainage** for the Derby will be 40%, in addition to the standard 5% NRHA show fee deduction.
11. **Competition License:** All horses competing in NRHA approved competition will be required to have a competition license. A completed competition license application must accompany the

entry if not previously applied for. A photocopy of breed registration papers must accompany application for registered horses. For non-registered horses, color photographs showing full left and right sides and full front and back views, specifically showing all marks of identification, must be submitted with the application. Owners are required to be general members of NRHA prior to completing the license process.

12. **Substitution / Transfer of entry:** There will be no substitutions of horses/entries for any reason.
13. **Change of ownership:** An entered horse may change ownership and retain entry status under the new owner, provided that the Change of Ownership Coupon is sent in, the transfer of the NRHA Competition License is complete, the new owner is a current NRHA general member, and the new owner maintains all payments.
14. **Payee:** Prize money will be paid to the owner as recorded in the NRHA database at the start of the event. Appropriate tax information must be on file with the NRHA Office. If ownership of the horse transfers during the NRHA Derby, the previous owner and the new owner must complete an Authorization of Prize Money Payment Form.

#### ***Amendment***

The 5% nominator's incentive will be deducted from all payouts in the Derby. If the horse is nominated, the 5% nominator's incentive will be paid to the nominator as listed in NRHA records. Appropriate tax information must be on file with the NRHA Office. If the horse is not nominated, the monies will be retained.

15. **Owners** may enter more than one horse. A horse may be entered only once per Derby (Open or Non Pro). Owners and riders must be current NRHA general members.
16. **Riders:** Riders may ride no more than three horses per Derby. Rider designation coupons must be received in the NRHA Office no later than June 15 (**POSTMARKS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED**). Rider Designations will not be taken over the phone. If the Rider Designation coupon is not received by June 15, the rider will be indicated as "Rider Not Designated" and NRHA is not responsible for draw positions closer than the conditions specify. In the Open draw, NRHA will attempt to separate horses with a common rider by at least twenty (20) horses or highest number possible. In the Non Pro draw, NRHA will attempt to separate horses with a common rider or owner by at least twenty (20) horses or highest number possible.
17. **Judges:** All decisions of the judges are final. There will be five judges placed at different points in the arena for the Derby; the high score and low score will be eliminated with only the total of the remaining three (3) scores used to determine the final score. A pre-check will be utilized.
18. **Judges fees:** There will be a \$160 judge's fee due with the March 1st payment. Only one judge's fee will be required for multiple division entries
19. **Video fees:** There will be a \$20.00 Video Fee due with the May 1st payment for each horse per class. For classes that run concurrent, there will be only one \$20.00 charge.
20. **Medications Testing:** All aged event entries are subject to anonymous, random examination/medications testing for research purposes. There will be a testing fee of \$10 due

with the May 1st payment. See the *NRHA Handbook* for all rules and procedures concerning Animal Welfare and Medications Rule. The individual identity of samples will remain anonymous. A medications report form is not required in this phase.

21. CLASSES will be operated in accordance with NRHA rules. The NRHA Officers and Board of Directors reserve the right to interpret these rules and regulations. All decisions will be final. By way of making an entry, the exhibitor is assuming responsibility for knowledge of NRHA rules and releases NRHA and its officers, directors and employees from any claims or losses.
22. **TIES:** In the event of a tie in the Level 4 Open, Level 3 Open, Level 2 Open, Level 1 Open, Prime Time Open, Level 4 Non Pro, Level 3 Non Pro, Level 2 Non Pro, Level 1 Non Pro, Prime Time Non Pro, or Youth Non Pro following their respective finals or composite results, the tie breaking procedures as outlined in the current year *NRHA Handbook* will be used to break the tie.
23. **CONDITION CHANGES:** The NRHA Board of Directors reserves the right to interpret, modify or amend conditions for the NRHA Derby & Show. If requiring immediate attention, those rights will be deferred to the Executive Committee.
24. **RIGHT TO CANCEL:** The NRHA reserves the right to cancel this event without notice at any time prior to the show without liability, but in such event will return all entry money to the subscribers. Interest earned on the entries is the property of the National Reining Horse Association.

Entries are received subject to the right of the NRHA Executive Board to refuse the entry without notice to the subscriber. Acceptance of the entry is based on the representations made on the entry form. Decisions of the Executive Committee will be final.

25. Riders are responsible to know and adhere to eligibility requirements for NRHA events. A rider who enters an event or division in which he/she is ineligible, will forfeit all winnings and entry fees to the NRHA, and be subject to disciplinary action by the NRHA Board of Directors for unsportsmanlike conduct as set forth in the *NRHA Handbook*. The rider is responsible for the entry information regardless of whether the form is completed by the agent or owner.
26. Show management reserves the right to discipline any person that it concludes has abused or permitted abusive behavior against a horse, or engaged in unsportsmanlike conduct toward show management, judges or exhibitors. Discipline may include official warning, elimination from competition or any other action deemed appropriate by the show management.

- All Derby Event conditions 1 through 26 shall apply.
- The NRHA Open Derby will consist of five divisions: Level 4 Open, Level 3 Open, Level 2 Open, Level 1 Open, and Prime Time Open. Entry into the Level 3 Open, Level 2 Open, and Level 1 Open will be automatic based on rider eligibility. Please see the current *NRHA Handbook* for eligibility requirements. For members giving up Non Pro cards please refer to the Non Pro conditions of the current *NRHA Handbook*.
- A total payment of \$1,690 is required to enter the Open Derby. The payment consists of an entry fee of \$1,500, \$160 judges fee, \$10 meds fee and \$20 video fee. A completed entry form plus the first payment of \$910 must be postmarked by March 1, 2012. A payment book will then be sent with coupons to return with the final payment. Separate division payments are required to enter the Prime Time division. See the Prime Time Conditions for full details. PLEASE NOTE: All payments are due on the prescribed due date even if the owner/agent has not received a payment book by the payment deadline.

6. **Prime Time Open Division:** All Derby event conditions 1 through 26 shall apply including Open Derby conditions 1 through 5. The Prime Time Open Division is open to any entry that is entered in the Open Derby and the rider's age is 50 or older as of January 1. Date of birth must be included on the Prime Time Open Division coupon. Any entry wishing to enter the Prime Time Open Division must indicate so by returning the appropriate coupon and \$200 by May 1 – **POSTMARKS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.** If received after May 1, but by 5:00 p.m. two days prior to the go round, a late fee of \$50 will apply. Prime Time Open division winners will be determined by the go round score and payback will be made using the NRHA Payback Schedule A from the current *NRHA Handbook*. Scores will be determined using a handicap system. Level 4 Open exhibitors will have 0 points per judge added to their final score, Level 3 Open exhibitors will have a half point per judge added to their final score, Level 2 Open exhibitors will have one (1) point per judge added to their final score, Level 1 Open exhibitors will have one (1) point per judge added to their final score.
7. The NRHA Open Derby will consist of one preliminary go round with all Level 4 Open, Level 3 Open, Level 2 Open, Level 1 Open, and Prime Time Open divisions running concurrently. The top 30 horses plus ties for the Level 4 Open, the top 25 horses plus ties for the Level 3 Open, the top 20 horses plus ties for the Level 2 Open, and the top 20 horses plus ties for the Level 1 Open will advance to a combined finals with those horses qualifying for only the Level 3 Open and/or Level 2 Open and/or Level 1 Open divisions showing in the first section. The remaining qualifiers (i.e., Level 4 Open and Level 4 Open/Level 3 Open/Level 2 Open/Level 1 Open divisions) will compete in the second section. The finals in each division will be a clean-slate format.
8. **PAYBACKS:** The NRHA Open Derby has \$215,000 added in the Level 4 Open division, \$135,000 added in the Level 3 Open division plus a \$300 per entry division allocation, \$55,000 added in the Level 2 Open division plus a \$200 per entry division allocation, \$25,000 added in the Level 1 Open plus a \$100 per entry division allocation, and \$5,000 added in the Prime Time Open division. All horses that advance to finals will receive a paycheck (exception: No Scores). Added monies are subject to change due to nomination money.

The nominator incentive (5% of the nominated horse's aged event earnings) will be paid to the nominator. The remaining 95% of the aged event earnings will be paid to the owner of the horse as it is listed in the NRHA database.

Five percent (5%) of the Level 3 Open, Level 2 Open and Level 1 Open division's purse will be paid to the top five go round winners in each division. 95% will be paid back for the finals in each division.

1. All Derby Event conditions 1 through 26 shall apply.
2. The NRHA Non Pro Derby will consist of six divisions: Level 4 Non Pro, Level 3 Non Pro, Level 2 Non Pro, Level 1 Non Pro, Prime Time Non Pro, and Youth Non Pro. Entry into the Level 3 Non Pro, Level 2 Non Pro, and Level 1 Non Pro will be automatic based on rider eligibility. Please see the current *NRHA Handbook* for eligibility requirements.
3. A total payment of **\$900** is required to enter the Non Pro Derby. The payment consists of an entry fee of **\$710**, **\$160** judges fee, **\$10 med fee** and \$20 video fee. A completed entry form plus the first payment of **\$520** must be postmarked by March 1, 2012. A payment book will then be sent with coupons to return with the final payment. Separate division payments are required to enter the Prime Time and Youth division. See the Prime Time and Youth Conditions for full details. PLEASE NOTE: All payments are due on the prescribed due date even if the owner/agent has not received a payment book by the payment deadline. Non Pro division must be indicated on the Entry form.

6. The NRHA Non Pro Derby will consist of one preliminary go round with all Level 4 Non Pro, Level 3 Non Pro, Level 2 Non Pro, Level 1 Non Pro, Prime Time Non Pro, and Youth Non Pro divisions running concurrently. The finals for the Level 4 Non Pro, Level 3 Non Pro, Level 2 Non Pro, Level 1 Non Pro and Prime Time Non Pro will be combined, with 30 horses plus ties qualifying for the Level 4 Non Pro, 25 horses plus ties qualifying for the Level 3 Non Pro, 20 horses plus ties qualifying for the Level 2 Non Pro, 20 horses plus ties qualifying for the Level 1 Non Pro, and 15 horses plus ties qualifying for the Prime Time Non Pro Finals. The finals in each division will be a clean-slate format.

7. **Prime Time Non Pro Division:** All Derby event conditions 1 through 26 shall apply including Non Pro Derby conditions 1 through 6. The Prime Time Non Pro Division is open to any entry that is entered in the Non Pro Derby and the rider is age 50 or older as of January 1. Date of birth must be included on the Prime Time Non Pro Division coupon. Any entry wishing to enter the Prime Time Non Pro division must indicate so by returning the appropriate coupon and \$200 by May 1 – **POSTMARKS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.** If received after May 1 but by 5:00 p.m. two days prior to the go round, a late fee of \$50 will apply. Prime Time Non Pro division winners will be determined by the finals score and payback will be made using the schedule listed in these conditions. Scores will be determined using a handicap system. Level 4 Non Pro exhibitors will have 0 points per judge added to their final score, Level 3 Non Pro exhibitors will have a half point (0.5) per judge added to their final score, Level 2 Non Pro exhibitors will have one (1) point per judge added to their final score, and Level 1 Non Pro exhibitors will have one (1) point per judge added to their final score.

8. **Youth Non Pro Derby:** All Derby Event Conditions 1 through 26 shall apply. Any Youth wishing to enter the Youth Non Pro Derby without entering the Non Pro Derby must do so by returning the

Youth Entry form, \$250 entry fee, \$110 judges Fee, \$10 med fee and \$20 video fee to the NRHA Office. Entries must be received in the Office on or before May 1.

Youth Derby entrants are not required to also enter the Non Pro Derby, however, if they wish to do so, they must enter by following the Non Pro Derby conditions and paying all fees by the posted deadlines.

Non Pro Derby entrants wishing to also enter the Youth Non Pro Derby may do so by returning the Youth Non Pro Derby coupon and a \$100 division payment.

Late entries will be accepted until 5:00 p.m. two days prior to the go round with no penalty. However, entries received June 15 and after will be included in a group to run before the regular draw in the reverse order in which they were received.

Stallions will be permitted to show in the Youth Non Pro Derby.

The winner will be determined by the go round score.

The jackpot purse shall be distributed using the following current *NRHA Handbook* Payback Schedule B percentages:

- PAYBACKS:** The NRHA Non Pro Derby has \$75,000\* added in the Level 4 Non Pro division plus a \$325 per entry division allocation, \$55,000\* added in the Level 3 Non Pro division plus a \$200 per entry division allocation, \$30,000\* added in the Level 2 Non Pro division plus a \$125 per entry division allocation, \$15,000\* added in the Level 1 Non Pro division plus a \$60 per entry division allocation, and \$5,000 added in the Prime Time Non Pro division. 5% of the Level 4 Non Pro, Level 3 Non Pro, Level 2 Non Pro, and Level 1 Non Pro divisions' purse will be paid to the top 10 go round winners in each division. 95% will be paid back in the finals in each division. All horses that advance to finals will receive a paycheck (exception: No Scores). Added monies are subject to change due to nomination monies.

The nominator incentive (5% of the nominated horse's aged event earnings) will be paid to the nominator. The remaining 95% of the aged event earnings will be paid to the owner of the horse as it is listed in the NRHA database.

## NRHA Sire & Dam Program Derby Conditions

All Derby Event conditions 1 through 26 shall apply, as well as any Open or Non Pro Derby conditions as stated previously. However, Sire & Dam entries are not required to be nominated into the Nomination Program in order to be eligible to enter the North American Derby. If the nominator wishes to participate in the Nominator Incentive, they must nominate the horse into the program. Any nominator incentive money earned by Sire & Dam horses that does not have a recorded nominator will be retained by NRHA.

**Entries** – Sire & Dam Program foals are eligible for the Open Division or the Non Pro Division at a reduced entry. For Open division entries a total payment of \$940 is required. The payment consists of an entry fee of \$750, \$160 judges fee, \$10 med fee and \$20 video fee. For Non Pro division entries a total payment of \$490 is required. The payment consists of an entry fee of \$300, \$160 judges fee, \$10 med fee and \$20 video fee. Fees are to be paid in one (1) payment. A completed Sire & Dam entry form plus the appropriate payment must be received by the NRHA Office by May 1st.

Due to the single payment, a payment book will not be sent. The rider must be designated on the entry form as well as if they are to be entered into the Open or Non Pro.
